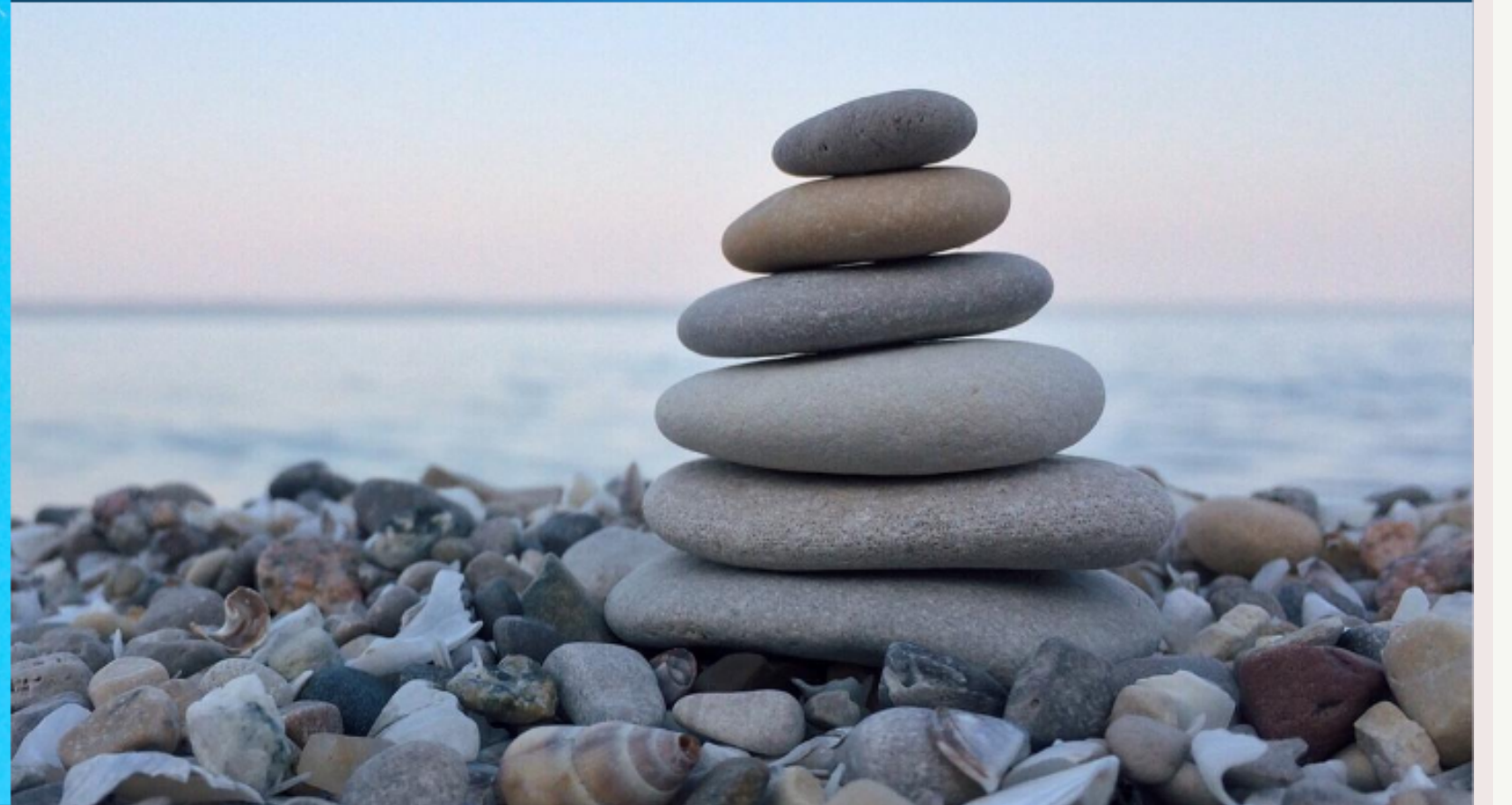
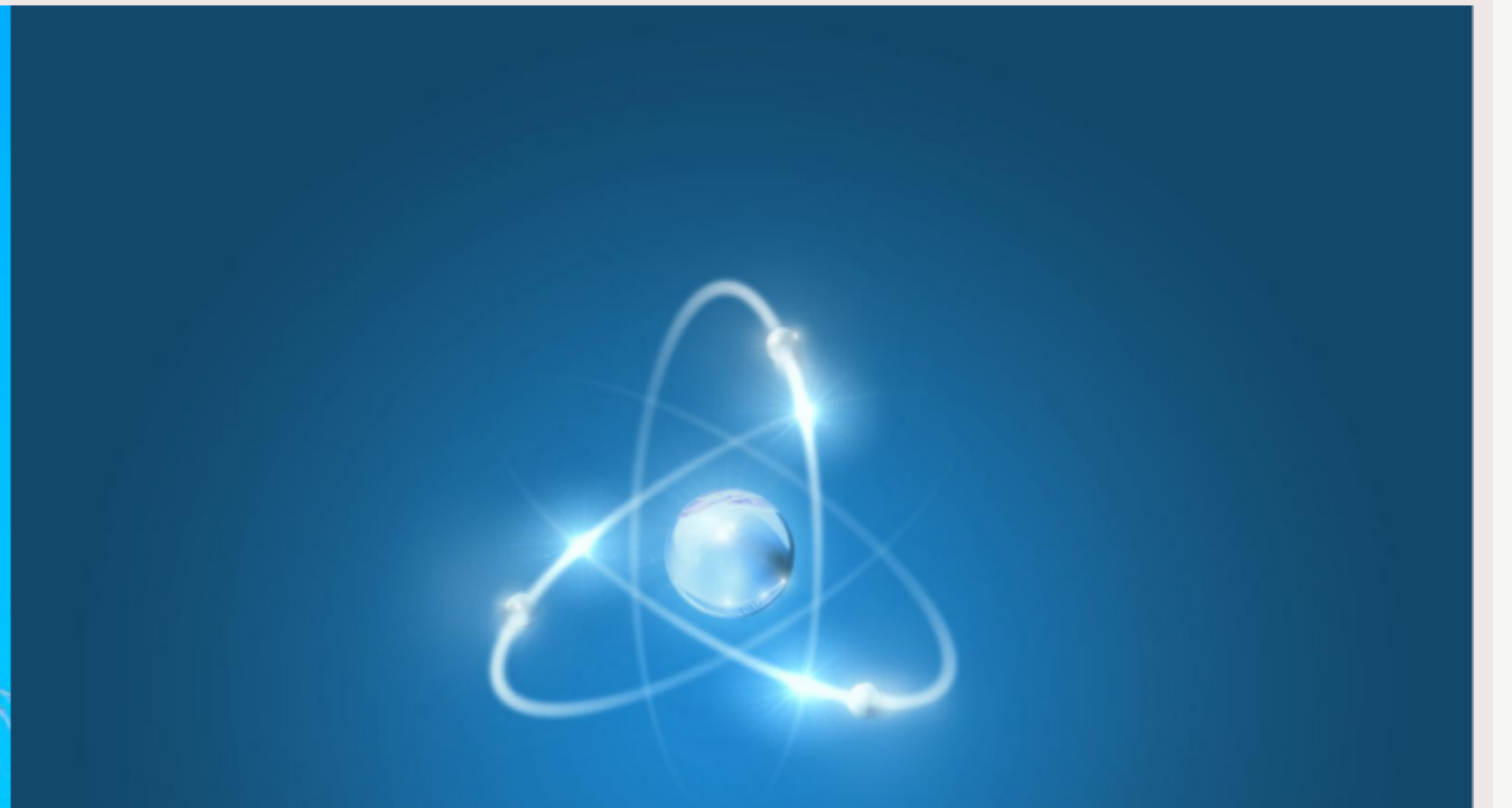

against the enemy.” - *Dance, Dance, Dance* p. 65

gil, gul, guwl - (rejoice; be joyful; glad; delight): To spin
around under the influence of any violent emotion (usually
joy); to go in a circle, to be glad, rejoice, exalt - *Dance, Dance,
Dance* p. 45

compass about him.

cabal - (compass, go about): To revolve, surround or border; to
revolve around a sacred object, walk whirl - *Dance, Dance, Dance* p. 27
